Amenities Include:

- Access to all parts of Chapter House:
- Hot lunches and dinners Monday -Thursday for a total of 9 hot meals with cold breakfast items available to each member. Meals are prepared by our professional chef, Chris.
- Kitchen furnished with professional grade appliances usable to members
- Sit-down dinners with entire chapter membership each night
- Free parking spaces on house property
- Six washer and dryer sets in the Chapter House for members to use
- Theatre room with 139" screen, 4K projector, and Dolby surround-sound system with an Apple TV/gaming system hook-up
- Mail alcove with individual mail slots for each member allowing for members to have their correspondence and mail sent directly to the house
- Study Lounge with seating for 20. Perfect for collaborating on homework and other academic endeavors
- "Bert's Bunker" furnished with ping pong table and various surfaces to work on design projects or socialize
- Pool room with seating nook and pool table
- Safety systems including fire and carbon monoxide detectors as well as a house-wide sprinkler-riser system
- Formal living room to socialize or hold small meetings
- Conference room where officer meetings as well as committee meetings are held. Also highly utilized as an interview room for those interviewing for internship or co-op opportunities
- Members reside on 2nd and 3rd floors, in either 2,3, or 4-man rooms. Each room is furnished with a bed, mattresses, desk and chair for each member, but they can bring whatever they like to furnish and decorate to make it their own space.
